Chamber Day at the Fair

August 1st is Chamber Day at the Fair

The day will begin with an **Eggs & Issues Breakfast** at the Fair being planned by the Agriculture Committee of the LVCC at **7:30 a.m.**

Keynote Speaker, **Dr. Greg Roth**, Professor, Penn State Crops and Soil Science Department, Grain Crop Specialist, will discuss: **"Status of Bio Fuels and the impact on Area Farmers."** Topics will include the updates Bio Fuels-Corn Ethanol, Cellulitic Ethanol and Soy Diesel.

As the extension grain crops specialist, Dr. Greg Roth develops educational programs for extension agents, agribusiness groups and producers on timely issues such as managing crops during drought stress, GMO issues, potential of specialty corn hybrids, managing for grain quality, organic grain production and producing corn for silage.

A key research focus has been managing corn for silage production using different hybrids and management strategies and then using various models to estimate the profitability of these practices on dairy farms along with studying the potential of added value wheat and barley varieties to try to create more opportunities for crop producers in the state.

All About You Catering will be providing this year's meal, blending perfectly with the "Luau by the Lake" theme.

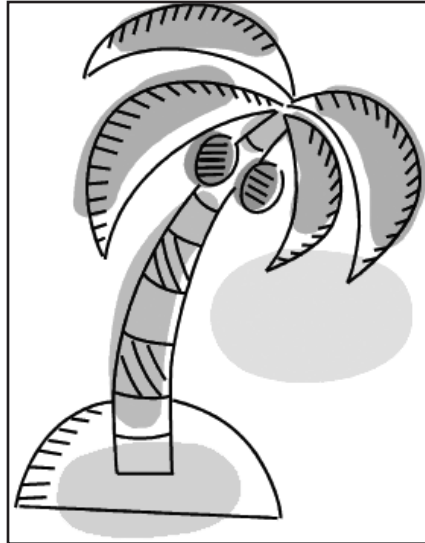
