Guidelines for Women in Business Committee's Scholarship

1. The Scholarship will be given on an annual basis; the winner will be announced at the June luncheon of the Women in Business Committee. The recipient will be asked to attend as our guest.
2. The Scholarship will be in an amount not to exceed \$1000.00 per student. This is a one time only award to each recipient, and will not be paid again in successive years of the recipient's education. The amount of the scholarship will be determined prior to the selection of the recipient by the Lebanon Valley Chamber Foundation Board, upon the recommendation of the Women in Business Committee. It is hoped that a minimum of \$400.00 will be collected each year.
3. The Scholarship will be given to the educational institution upon receipt of invoice. Eligible expenses include: tuition, books, and fees.
4. **Eligibility guidelines are:**
 - a. Student must be a non-traditional student, defined as over 25 years of age, or have single parent/displaced homemaker status and be a non-resident student at the institution where she/he is studying.
 - b. Student must be at least 1/2 time, defined as registered for at least 6 credit hours (2 courses) per semester in the year of receiving the scholarship (excluding summer).
 - c. Students must be attending an accredited institution granting **2 year and/or four year degrees** and must be matriculated into an Associate's or Bachelor's degree program. Major field is open.
 - d. Decision will be based on merits of application (attached) without regard to financial status. Decision of the Lebanon Valley Chamber Foundation Board, is final.
 - e. Recipient must either reside in Lebanon County or attend an institution in the area served by the Lebanon Valley Chamber of Commerce.
5. The Scholarship will be funded by the activities of the Women in Business Committee. Money will be set aside in a separate account dedicated to this specific purpose.
6. It is hoped the recipient will become active at the appropriate time in Chamber of Commerce activities.
